- [8x8 Fluid 300LB Cold Press Watercolor Paper](#)
- Masking Fluid – I used [Monster Latex](#)
- [Small bottle with fine tip](#)
- Viva Paper Towels – I cut into squares, works great!
- 2 Jars for water
- #4 and #6 Round Watercolor Paint Brushes
- [20/0 Liner Brush](#) – I used Princeton
- 4-inch flat brush - **Optional**
- Old Toothbrush
- Palette, any type
- [Cold Wax Medium](#)
- Brayer
- Plastic Scraper – old credit card
- [Fixatif Spray](#) - **Optional**

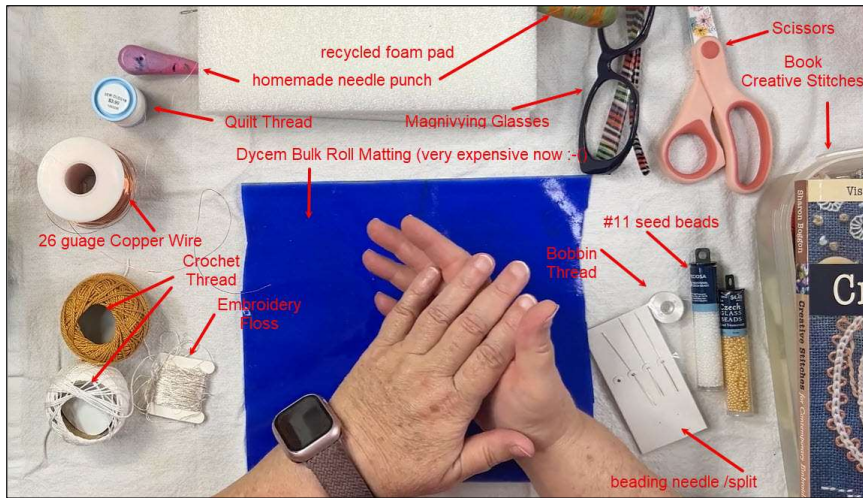

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# Beading and Embroidery Stitching

**NOTE:** You will only need the items listed below. We will not be using wire, crochet thread, or embroidery floss. This is just what I have in my Tool Box 😊



- Scissors
- Sharp Embroidery Needle or punch (**I have a tutorial in the Gifties section on how to make your own sharp needle punch**)
- Sewology Quilt Thread – white
- Bobbin Thread or beading thread. I used bobbin thread since it holds well enough and beading thread can be a bit pricey and harder to find.
- Thread Conditioner or Bees Wax
- #11 Czech glass seed beads
- [#11 Beading Needle](#) There are many different needles out there, but this is the best size. You can also get the type of needle that splits, just make sure it is a size 11 or 10 so it will go through the hole of the beads.
- Foam Pad is a plus, I used a foam piece of packing material...love it!

- Magnifying Glass (Optional)
- [Creative Stitches Book \(Optional\)](#)

**NOTE:** I used a Non-Slip piece of Dycem. I love this stuff but have learned that the price has doubled since the last time I bought it, so I am not suggesting you purchase this. You can find nonslip rubber mats that will do the job!
