

WATERCOLOR PAINTING

1 - 9x12 Watercolor paper/ or 5x7 blank Watercolor card (this is what I used) optional

Tape

Watercolors Used

- Prima Essence Set - #98, #100,
- Prima Vintage Pastels - #111 #113, #114
- Prima Tropical - #17

Charcoal stick or pencil (optional – graphite pencil-water soluble)

Regular pencil for drawing thin lines

Eraser

Graphite paper (optional)

BEADWORK

#15 seed beads – about 10

#13 or 12 needle

Beading thread

Scissors

Beading wax – (optional)

WIREWORK

28 gauge wire – I used brass, but you can use whatever you like

Wire cutters – optional as this is thin enough wire to cut with scissors without damaging your scissors

Hole punch – this is also optional as you can use a 3 inch doll needle with a very sharp tip. I show you how to make your own hole punch for this project.

Nylon pliers – this is optional but are quite handy if you decide to use more wire. This is used for straightening your wire as you work with it.
